

Verify the firearm is unloaded!

With the stock removed disassemble the action to replace the recoil buffer.



Looking at the action after removing the two pins. There's a small piece that's easy to get out, but fiddly to put back in.

Comparison of the old buffer with it's replacement.

Installing the new buffer is simple. After removing the bolt assembly, take a wide bladed flathead screwdriver and carefully pry the old one out. The round part on the back of the buffer fits snugly into a hole at the rear of the action.
